



The Msungwana ovaya program focuses on providing educational support to primary school girls.

During this first quarter, we have worked with the same two schools, Zingwangwa Primary School as well as Chimwankhunda Primary School to track progress and evaluate the program.

After rendering support to the students last year, our community mobilizers re-visited the schools to track progress. The program has yielded positive results as teachers reported a significant improvement in the students' performance.

Increase our fundraising base, with 10% of funding sourced locally.


Through donations from local well wishers as well as internal funds generation activities, we managed acquire funds to help us run our day to day activities.

Through interactive discussions, students were offered motivational talks and


career guidance.


